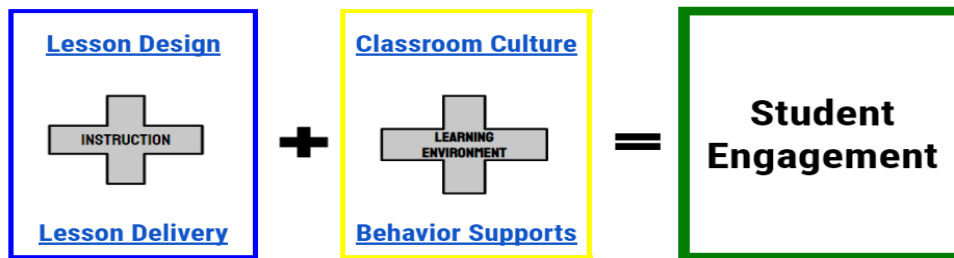


# Planning for Student Engagement

## Proactive Design

- ♦ Do you know what you are teaching and have it organized in a plan book?

Designing lessons for student engagement requires a great deal of up-front planning but is well worth the time. This six hour class will walk you through the steps of planning engaging lessons and then delivering them to students. The delivery is the **implementation of the details** you planned before the students arrived.

We will help you set a structure for planning lessons. We will focus on planning for the teacher and the students at every point in the lesson. We will analyze objectives and the audience they are written for, work towards making learning visible, discuss ways to be more purposeful in seating/grouping, and evaluate how to monitor for learning.
